GBMS Board of Directors is seeking interested patients to serve on our board. We are working to make sure our board represents our patient population. We are particularly hoping to add a Hispanic patient and another representative of the migrant and seasonal farm worker community to the board.

Migratory and Seasonal Farmworker (MSFW): Per section 330(g)(3)(A) of the PHS Act, the term “migratory agricultural worker” means “an individual whose principal employment is in agriculture, who has so been so employed within the last 24 months, and who establishes for the purposes of such employment a temporary abode.” Per section 330(g)(3)(B), “seasonal agricultural worker” means “an individual whose principal employment is in agriculture on a seasonal basis and who is not a migratory agricultural worker.”

Our Board Members help ensure that Greater Baden is meeting its mission and making the best decisions for the patients, staff, and organization.

Board Members are expected to attend or participate in meetings each month (4th Thursday of the month) and participate in committees as requested by the Chair of the Board.

Members should be able to receive communication by phone or e-mail and be able to communicate ideas with others in a group.

Since service to the board is voluntary, Greater Baden may provide reimbursement for child care expenses and transportation costs associated with board service.

Training will be provided for all new board members. Board service is a great opportunity to “give back” to our community and make sure high quality health care is available for all.
